NOTES ON SCHOOL ATTENDANCE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

ABSENT NOTES:

When your child is absent, parents/guardians should send in a written excuse note with their child indicating the reason for the absence. Until this note is received, children are marked illegally absent in their records.

WHAT IS CONSIDERED A LEGAL ABSENCE?

Legal absences accepted by the state include: sickness, medical appointments and religious observances. For a complete list, please refer to the Glenham Student Handbook issued to all students at the beginning of the school year.

EXTENDED ABSENCES:

A doctor's note is required after a student's absence extends 5 days or more.

ABSENCES and AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES:

If your child is absent from school due to illness, they MAY NOT participate in after school functions. This includes concert performances, PTO fun nights and sporting events.
