### Stomach virus and the flu are on the rise in our area.

Please remember it is our policy that a student is picked up from school immediately for temperatures over 100 and/or vomiting. Please have a backup plan in place for your child to be picked up from school.

They must then stay home from school for a minimum of 24 hours without vomiting and/or with their temperature below 100 without the use of fever reducing medication.

Remind your children to wash their hands frequently with warm water and soap after they use the bathroom and throughout the day.

Hooray for our Glenham Students as they think of others!


## PRE-K REGISTRATION 2018-2019
