We will be quizzing multiplication and division early in September and all year long. Knowing skip counting will make math much easier for you! MAKE THAT A SUMMER GOAL! After all your hard work in Grade 3, you should be skilled in addition and subtraction with regrouping.

This coming year will be an exciting and busy one. Together we will explore and learn about many new things! We are looking forward to meeting you! :o)

**Parents,** at this grade level, your child is becoming more independent. Although we wish to encourage this, your child still needs your guidance and supervision. Together we can make it a successful year. Your child should be reading over the summer. Attached is our Grade 4 supply list.
