Starting this week, today, Monday, March 23rd and going forward, meal pick-up will be on Mondays and Wednesdays. On Mondays you will be picking up two breakfasts and two lunches per child and on Wednesdays you will be picking up three breakfasts and three lunches per child BHS pick up is from 10:00 am - 10:30 am and South Ave pick up is from 10:30 am - 11:00am. If you are having difficulties getting to the meal sites because of illness, self-quartainting, disability, or something else, please email Matt Landahl at landahl.m@beaconk12.org with your name, your children's names, your address, and phone number. There are volunteers who will drop the meals off next week at your doorstep.

During this week, if you have any questions, concerns, or just need to reach out please contact us, as all principals will be accessible during this time. Teachers return for additional extended learning planning next week and will be in contact with students/families March 31st with more information to look ahead for the rollout of our extended comprehensive distance learning plan in the case that we are closed beyond April 1st.
