Although you began working on these skills in 3rd, we will review them in the beginning of the year, and then build upon them as the year goes on.

**Parents**, at this grade level, your child is becoming more independent. Although we wish to encourage this, your child still needs your guidance and supervision. Together we can make it a successful year!
