


LOCKER ROOM:

3. Do not leave locks on lockers overnight, locks will be removed.
4. Shower before entering the pool
5. The Physical Education staff and Beacon City School District are not responsible for theft!
6. **Enter the pool through the locker room**

AQUATIC ATTIRE:

1. Women preferable one piece swim suit (no thong bottoms)
2. Men preferable loose fitting swim suit (no cut off shorts or thongs)
3. T-Shirts are acceptable
4. Bathing caps must be worn if hair beyond the shoulders
5. No jewelry


We ask all patrons to enjoy the Aquatic Center and follow these simple rules:

GENERAL AQUATIC RULES:

1. No one is allowed in the pool area without certified supervision.
2. Contact lenses or eyeglasses may not be worn in the pool area.
3. Running, pushing, or horse play in the pool or locker room is not permitted.
4. **Diving boards are off limits at all times.**
5. Diving in the shallow end or water less than 5 feet in depth is not permitted.
6. Diving backwards off the side of the pool is prohibited
7. Urinating, spitting, or blowing nose in the water is prohibited
8. Directions given by the lifeguard must be followed at all times.
9. Beginners & non swimmers must stay in shallow end
10. Spectators not participating in the swimming activity must sit quietly in the benches.
11. Food items are not allowed on the pool deck including (Chewing gum)
12. No inflatable floatation devices allowed.
13. All individuals must shower hair and entire body before entering the pool.
14. No persons having the following: skin lesions, sores, inflamed eyes or mouth, and nose or ear discharge will not be permitted to use the pool.
15. The Beacon City School District, staff and employees are not responsible for lost, damage, or stolen items.
16. Glass bottles are not permitted in the locker room or pool deck.
17. **Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by adult 18 years of age or older.**
18. Lifeguard has the right to remove any patron that does not follow posted, written rules or verbal direction.
