The West Point Chapter of the American Society of Military Comptrollers (ASMC) announces its 2018 chapter scholarship program. The ASMC is a non-profit professional society that promotes professional development in all aspects of military financial management. The objective of the ASMC Scholarship program is to recognize outstanding graduating high school seniors for academic achievement and to provide financial assistance in the amount of a \$500.00 scholarship to assist in accomplishing future educational goals. Top finalist in the West Point Chapter scholarship competition will be considered for submission to the ASMC National Scholarship Committee for further competition. The ASMC National Scholarship program awards scholarships in the amount of \$ 1000.00 and \$ 2000.00.

The ASMC Scholarship criteria and submission requirements are as follows:

- Nominee must be an outstanding graduating high school senior in final half of his/her school year.
- Nominee must be entering a field of study directly related to financial/resource management (business administration, economics, public administration, computer science or operations research related to financial management, accounting or finance).
- Nominee must have two letters of recommendation, the first from the high school principal, academic dean or high school teacher and the second from a community leader.
- Applicant must be submitted on the attached official ASMC National Scholarship form (photocopy accepted).
- Applicants are required to provide a copy of their high school transcript and if possible a copy of their college acceptance letter.
