# 3. Legislative & Policy

- Vote to change name of school holiday, discuss communication to community
- Bipartisan Safer Communities Act
  - DOE grant applications for 2 programs to increase access to mental health services for students, totaling \$280 million funded in part through the Bipartisan Safer Communities Act (BSCA). The first of \$1 billion in funds awarded over the next 5 years.
  - Grant Program #1: <u>School-Based Mental Health Services</u> (SBMH), provides funding to schools to increase the number of credentialed school-based mental health professionals.
  - Grant Program #2: <u>Mental Health Service Professional Demonstration</u> (MHSP), support hiring more school-based mental health workers in high-need districts by boosting the mental health profession pipeline.
