3. Advocacy

- Governor Hochul Education Priorities
 - Fully funding Foundation Aid by the 2023-2024 school year
 - Simplifying and speeding up teacher certification process
 - State grants to provide mental health support, and a new state program (Recover from COVID School Program) matching federal funds that districts dedicate to mental health (e.g., more mental health staff/services)
- Updates from LHEC Advocacy Meeting BCSD BOE Priorities
 - Earmarked funds to address mental health needs based on concrete district feedback (e.g., creating more half-day facilities for students)
 - o Foundation Aid formula
 - Clear, shared guidelines for when to phase out masks
 - Free school meals for all public school students
 - Permanently de-couple APPR and state tests
 - Plan to avoid sudden budget gaps once federal Covid funds end
 - No-excuse absentee ballots
 - Adjustments to graduation requirements, including needs assessment tailored to in-demand occupations in NYS
