# Final NYS Budget

Adoption of the NYS Budget for 2021-22 saw an increase in Foundation Aid

Expense driven aids remain the same and did not get combined into Services Aid

There is no Local District funding reduction

**UPK Expansion - additional money for full day conversion** 

New Property Tax Relief Credit for homeowners - Income eligible

No changes to STAR

# Federal Stimulus Money- Targeted for Specific Areas

- ESSER Fund CARES Act \$822,000 -Covered PPE, outside tents, extra cleaning supplies, ventilation
- 2. ESSER II Fund CRRSA Act \$2.6 million- PPE, outside shade structures, ventilation, cleaning supplies, cleaning, staff
- 3. ARP American Rescue Plan Act \$4.2 million- ventilation infrastructure in schools, academic learning loss, remote education costs, social/emotional supports for students
