

On behalf of the Mohawk-Hudson Section of the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE), we would like to offer your qualifying graduating seniors a scholarship opportunity. Each year the Mohawk-Hudson Section offers scholarships to graduating seniors seeking to continue their education with the goal of becoming a practicing civil engineer. This year we are offering two (2) 4-year, \$1,000 per year scholarships!

We invite you to share this invitation with your graduating seniors who intend to enroll in an ABET accredited Civil Engineering curriculum leading to a Bachelor of Science Degree. Applicants who intend to enroll in a certified two-year Civil Engineering Technology program with the intent of transferring to an ABET accredited school to obtain a bachelor's degree also qualify. We highly encourage all qualifying students from your school to submit an application.

Two winners will be selected from all the qualifying applications received. Judging for the awards will be conducted by our section's scholarship committee. The scholarship is planned to be presented to the winners on May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023, at 5:30PM at the Italian American Community Center during the section's annual dinner meeting.

**Important Scholarship Award Conditions:**

1. The scholarship award amount of \$1,000 per year for up to 4 years is renewable annually at the sole discretion of the ASCE Mohawk-Hudson Section and may be suspended and/or not renewed if the conditions herein are not satisfied.
2. To remain eligible for the scholarship award, the recipient shall:
  - a. Submit his/her transcript at the end of each school year to the Mohawk-Hudson Section;
  - b. Minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher is expected (Award may be continued for GPA between 2.5 and 3.0 at the discretion of the Mohawk-Hudson Section Board), and;
  - c. Remain enrolled in an educational institution majoring in a curriculum leading to an ABET accredited Bachelor of Science Degree in the field of Civil Engineering.
