Detective Brian J. Ferrone Scholarship

The Detective Brian J. Ferrone Memorial Scholarship was established in 1981 by the Patrolmen's Benevolent Association of the City of Beacon Police Department to perpetuate the memory of him. Det. Ferrone was an eight year member of the Beacon Police Department who lost his life in an unfortunate accident on July 11, 1981.

Brian spent those eight years on the police force in total dedication to the needs of the people whom he served. Brian realized the importance of higher education as a means of achieving self-fulfillment in life. He attended several colleges, police training schools and was a graduate of the FBI National Academy.

In addition to the "Memorandum of Required Facts", which should be first in the cover, we require the following, preferably in the order indicated:

- 1. A statement of not more than 300 words prepared by the applicant summarizing school and out-of-school activities and accomplishments, and stating the applicants objective of further education, which the applicant thinks qualify him/her for the scholarship award. Please do not duplicate reports of accomplishments. Name of college, or trade school will be attending.
- 2. A letter from a parent presenting a true picture of the family situation and showing applicant's need of financial assistance to continue school.
- 3. A transcript of applicant's educational history while in high school.
- 4. A comprehensive letter of recommendation covering character, personality and scholarship of the applicant from at least one person, but not more than three, in authority, in each school

Schedule of Award

A \$1,500.00 award will be given to a winner on a continuous annual basis for a maximum of four years, for a college or trade school.

- ** It is understood that each winner must provide proof of re-enrollment to a college or trade school on an annual basis.
- ** An alternate will be selected in the event that the winner does not fulfill the rules and regulations of the scholarship.
