The Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks (Elks) 2023 Scholarship Season has begun.

The "Most Valuable Student Scholarship" is an Elks national scholarship program that provides 500 four-year awards that range from \$50,000 to \$4,000.

There are:

- Two (one male, one female) first-place awards of \$50,000 over four years (\$12,500/year).
- Two second-place awards of \$40,000 over four years (\$10,000/year).
- Two third-place awards of \$30,000 over four years (\$7,500/year).
- 14 finalists receive awards of \$20,000 over four years (\$5,000/year).
- 480 runners-ups will receive \$4,000 over four years (\$1,000/year).

This is available to ALL High School Seniors and American Citizens (your parents or you 'do not' have to be a member of the Elks). Scholarship application must be completed on-line.
