#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

To be eligible for this scholarship you must:

- Be of Hispanic Origin (Latino)
- Be a high school senior in Dutchess, Orange, or Ulster Counties
- Have a college acceptance letter

#### **Selection Criteria**

#### Applicants will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- · Academic Achievements and Community Service
- Completed Essay
- GPA Score
- Letters of recommendation from teacher or school official

#### **Application Preparation**

- 1. Complete the Personal Information, High School Information, and College Information section.
- 2. Attach a copy of your most recent high school transcript.
- 3. Attach a copy of your college acceptance letter.
- 4. Complete the Personal Statement Form which requires your signature.
- 5. Have a teacher or guidance counselor review your application and complete the Recommendation Form.
- 6. Place all materials in one envelope and postmark on or before April 14, 2023.\*
- 7. If e-mailing the application, ALL supporting documents must be attached in a single email and sent to: norma@hvlatinoscholarship.org on or before April 14, 2023.\*
