










### Dutchess County Tax Rates per \$1,000

## Tax Levy Percentage Increase





# EV Bus Proposition 2023

- Voters approved proposition to purchase an EV bus with a maximum cost of \$466,000 only if we received a grant of \$250,000
  - Current cost of an EV bus & Level 3 charger- \$495,000

We were awarded the NY School Bus Incentive Voucher **Program (NYSBIP) - \$257,250** 



## What will be on the ballot in May 2024?

Amend the language of Proposition 3 from May 2023 to increase the net cost of the EV bus. Include authorization to purchase a second bus with the same net cost.



## Additional Bus Proposition

**Proposition to purchase:** 3 - 72 passenger buses - \$485,000

**BCSD receives 59.9% of transportation aid** spread over five years We will finance the cost over 5 years
