COMPLIANCE – LEAD IN WATER TESTING

- NYS Dept. of Health (NYS DOH)
- Subpart 67-4 of Title 10 of the Codes, Rules, and Regulations of the State of New York
- Action Level:
- > > 15 ppb
- > 2025 reduced to > 5 ppb

COMPLIANCE - LEAD IN WATER TESTING



- Purchased 125 point-of-use filtered fixtures (fed stimulus \$)
- Reduce lead content at fixtures used for drinking water
- Limit the potential impact of testing results exceeding action level

ASBESTOS HAZARD EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACT (AHERA)

40 CFR Part 763, Subpart E

12 NYCRR Part 56

- Initial inspection/ management plan
- > Tri-annual inspections
- > 6 mo. Surveillance inspections
- ➤ Identify Designated Person
- > Staff training

- Complete AHERA Management Plan
- Current on Tri-annual and 6 mo.
 Surveillance inspections
- Annual staff training complete
- Removal of some ACM last summer

ASBESTOS HAZARD EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACT (AHERA)

- additional ACM removal scheduled this summer
- Planning for more ACM removal in future capital project
- Continue to work with BOCES H&S for ACM inspections, condition assessments, and sampling

- Continue routine inspections
- Enhance staff training
- Additional fire safety system improvements this summer
- Planning system improvements in future capital projects



IAQ - INDOOR AIR QUALITY

Recap

- Utilizing a grant through Dutchess
 Co. DOH
 - District received >\$35,000 in filters for portable air scrubbers

- New unit ventilators being installed summer 24 and 25
- Portable air scrubbers can be used in health offices or areas with minimal mechanical or natural ventilation

PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE

Identified PM as a means to:

- Improve system performance
- Extend equipment life
- Reduce frequency of emergency repairs
- Improve building comfort
- Increase energy efficiency

- Implemented ML Drawings Program
- Identify building assets
- Generate preventative maintenance tasks

PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE

- Continue to identify and implement PM tasks
- Adding PMs for new equipment
- Staff training

STAFF DEVELOPMENT

- Clearly defined roles and responsibilities
- Staff trainings
 - BOCES safety training all staff
 - Custodial and Maintenance Workshops – full day training



STAFF DEVELOPMENT

- Adding assessment tools
- Implement an automated time and attendance system
 - Save time
 - Improve accuracy



CONSERVATION

- Retired one gas powered string trimmer and replaced with electric
- MTE Equipment Solutions Inc. –
 electric zero-turn mower demo
- Installed solar/wind site lighting



CONSERVATION

- Continue to explore zero emissions options for all new tools and equipment
- Some energy efficiency improvements taking place this summer
- Planning for energy efficiency improvements to district facilities in future capital projects

- New heat plants at Sargent and JVF
- Site paving at Sargent and RMS
- Roofing at RMS and HS
- Hallway ceiling, LED lighting and emergency lighting at Sargent and JVF

- RMS
 - Switch gears replaced
 - Unit ventilators
 - Structural roof work
 - Corridor ceilings and lighting

- Beacon HS
 - TV Studio alterations
 - Alterations to classrooms C125 and C150
 - Replace grease interceptor kitchen
- JVF
 - Replace classroom unit ventilators
 - Replace grease interceptor kitchen

- Glenham
 - Additional parking lot
 - Replacing existing bus loop and parking
 - Asbestos abatement
 - Security vestibule

- Sargent
 - New library
 - Staircase guardrails
 - Replace grease interceptor kitchen
- South Ave.
 - Hallway lighting
 - Emergency lighting
 - Replace grease interceptor kitchen


To facilitate this summer's construction, department staff will prepare
