Example of how thorough you should be in completing your reading guides:

From page 2 of Reading Guide 1.1:

Cultures of Central and South America...

- 3 highly developed civilizations
 - o Maya (300-800AD)- built "remarkable" cities
 - Aztecs- (Yucatan Peninsula) after the decline of the Maya, capital: Tenochtitlan-population 200k, equivalent to European cities, corn (maize)
 - o Incas- (Peru) large empire, potatoes
- All three had extensive trade, accurate calendars, cultivated crops for stable food supply

Cultures of North America...

- Unsure of total population (1-10 million) by 1490
- Smaller and less sophisticated than Maya, Aztec, and Inca-reason: slow spread of maize north
- Most complex societies disappeared by 1400's, unsure why
- Semi-permanent settlements, max 300 people
- Men hunted, women gathered

Language...

- Not like European with single branch of language
- 20 language "families" led to 400 distinct languages

Identify one key similarity and one key difference between societies that developed in Central and South America to those that developed in North America.

Similarity: All societies adapted to their environment. Ex. Growing the best crops for their region, using irrigation, types of dwellings, and division of labor based on gender

Difference: Central and South American societies were more advanced technologically and also created large cities. North American societies were much smaller and ranged from nomadic to semi-nomadic in search of food.
