Additionally, students are required to pass the Regents Exam in US History and Government in June.

Prerequisites for the course

- Grade Requirement
 - 90% or above overall average in Global Studies and Geography II
 - <u>OR</u>
 - 85% or above overall average in Global Studies and Geography II Honors
- Regents Requirement
 - 85% or above on Global Studies and Geography Regents Exam

You will be dropped from the course if you do not meet these requirements.

Why purchase this book?

- It directly aligns with your reading guides that you will be required to complete throughout the school year
- You can mark it up and take notes in it
- It also aligns with the new curriculum, has test taking strategies and high quality practice questions
- It also serves as a supplemental text with alternate, shorter reading assignments for each unit rather than using the textbook *Out of Many*

What are my options with purchasing this book?

- If you are completely sure you will be taking the course and staying in the course, purchase the book during the summer.
- If you are unsure about staying in the course, you can purchase the book once the school year starts and borrow one of my books that I have in my classroom.
 - Just know that I do not have enough for every student to borrow a book so you might not be able to get one every day or exactly when you want one. *I currently have less than 20 copies for students to borrow.
- If purchasing a book online is an issue for you, we can do an order through the school which would allow you to pay with a check or money order and not have to pay shipping. We would do this once the school year started.
 The drawback of this option is that you might not get your book until well into October.
- There is a PDF of the 2015 version of the book available to you for <u>free</u> when you log-in to Google Classroom

Remind is "a communication tool that helps teachers connect instantly with students and parents. Send quick, simple messages to any device". To sign up, download the app or go to remind.com and use the code **@apushclem OR text @apushclem to 81010**

Google Classroom is where you will be receiving many of your notifications throughout the school year. It is also where handouts will be "housed" and where some class discussions will take place. I will be populating the files this summer and it might be a good place for you to check out. You will need to be signed up prior to attending Boot Camp.

- To join: <u>I have signed you up using your school emails</u>. You will need to log in to your email and accept the invitation to Google Classroom. If you happen to have any issues, here is the procedure to sign up.

 - Please only sign up with your BCSD email address. (If you are unsure of your email address, be sure to visit the Library prior to the end of the school year.)
