PE classes will begin on Monday July  $8^{th}$ , Monday-Thursday, until Thursday, August 1. Students who are absent from class 2 times, regardless of the circumstance, will be expelled from the class and will not be authorized to obtain PE credit.

The purpose of the Grad-Point Credit Recovery Program is to offer students the opportunity to earn credits for courses he/she has failed to complete successfully. Students will participate in an online, virtual program through which they will receive instruction and complete assignments, tests, and quizzes. A certified instructor will be present for each session and will be available to assist students with questions and system navigation. Students are expected to employ various note-taking and study strategies to ensure successful completion of the program.

I understand the following:

- The Grad Point Credit Recovery Program is a unique, self-paced opportunity to recover a failed grade in a course.
- Enrollment in this program is a privilege.
- The Credit Recovery Course(s) must be completed by August 12, 2019 or you will be reenrolled in the course(s) for the 2019-2020 school year.
- Seats in the lab are filled on a first-come, first-serve basis and that space will be limited to the number of available computers and/or licenses per session.
- My child understands that the minimum proficiency required for the Credit Recovery Program is 80% (eighty percent). Credit cannot be awarded until this level of proficiency is achieved.
- My child may work at home on lessons from the course but all pretests and posttests must be completed and proctored at school.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION IS A REQUIREMENT FOR GRADUATION BY NEW YORK STATE. ALL STUDENTS MUST PASS 4 FOUR YEARS OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION (2 Total Credits) TO MEET THIS REQUIREMENT.

- 1. Completion of this course will allow a student to obtain .5 credit of PE.
- 2. There will be a total of 16 class sessions at 3 hours each.
- 3. Classes will begin on Monday July 8th and will take place for 4 weeks, Monday-Thursday, until Thursday, August 1.
- 4. Classes will run from 8am-11am daily and will meet at the location determined by the course instructor.
- 5. Students who are more than 30m late to class, regardless of the circumstance, will be considered as absent for that day.
- 6. Students who are absent from class 2 times, regardless of the circumstance, will be expelled from the class and will not be authorized to obtain PE credit.
- 7. If a student is late to class 4x, regardless of the circumstance, it will be considered as 1 absence.
- 8. Students are expected to show up to class dressed in PE attire, including athletic footwear. Students who are not dressed appropriately will not be authorized to participate in that days' class session.
- 9. Students who receive a Failing grade (F) for 2 class sessions, will be expelled from the class and will not be authorized to obtain PE credit.
