## Band

### All Students Need:

#### 1. Instrument

- If you have your instrument from last year, you are all set.
- If you borrowed a school instrument, I highly recommend renting or purchasing an instrument.
- Please contact me before purchasing an instrument. We do have a few school instruments for students to borrow.

#### 2. Pencils

### Saxophone and Clarinet Students:

#### 1. Reeds

- I recommend Rico Reeds (the orange box). Box of 10, 2 1/2 strength. When purchasing reeds, be careful to purchase reeds for the instrument your child plays.

### Percussionists:

#### 1. Mallet bag containing: Snare sticks, Rubber Xylophone mallets, and Marimba mallets.
