Message from the Athletic Director

This was truly an amazing year of accomplishments. This year's senior class was unprecedented as four athletes signed NCAA Division One scholarships. Congratulations to Beacon's version of the "core four"; Tony Romanelli – Wake Forest, Talah Hughes – St. Peters, Taurus Phillips – Villanova, and Noriana Radwan to UCONN. In addition, there are many more seniors who will be trying out for Division Three and Junior College teams.

At the NYS Wrestling Championships, senior, Andrew Grella placed 2nd, becoming Beacon's first wrestler to make it to state finals. Senior James Brown made it to the podium in his 3rd trip to the Indoor State Track Championships, garnering 6th place in the high jump and a 3rd place finish in the Spring Track and Field Championships.

And finally two of our senior athletes were recognized as All Americans in baseball; Tony Romanelli and Patrick Schetter. Tony was also awarded the prestigious Athlete of the Year Award at the Elks Club Night of Champions.

In addition to the many athletic achievements by our seniors, there were many outstanding performances by our underclassman. Qualifying for the NYS Indoor and Spring Track Championships, Beacon sent three sophomores, Paige Baisley, Terrel Davis and Rayvon Grey to the states. Rayvon went on to place 2nd in long jump in both the Indoor and Spring Championships.

As the Director of Athletics, I am very proud of how our teams competed and conducted themselves. The greatest compliment our school district can receive is from another athletic director or school district administrator. This year, I received many compliments about our athletes and teams for their conduct and quality of play. I also received many compliments for our outstanding athletic facilities and ability to organize with great success many invitational and sectional events. The compliments kept coming when we hosted the NYS Regional Finals for Boys Basketball and the Class B Track and Field Championships.

Once again our athletes proved that they can excel in the classroom as well in athletics as nearly 65% of our athletes earned scholar athlete recognition and 15 teams earned the NYSPHSAA Scholar Team Athlete Award. Congratulations to this year's Girls Golf Team who earned the highest GPA among our varsity teams with an average of 95.1. Many of our graduating seniors, will be attending numerous prestigious colleges and universities.

During the fall season, it was fun to watch the number of points the football team put up on the scoreboard each game. Our girls' soccer and volleyball teams all won sectional games and our girls swim and tennis teams battled for league championships. The winter season had many team accomplishments including League Championships for the boys' track and girls' basketball team. The boy's track team ended the season as the number one Class B team in NYS. The boys and girls basketball teams played exciting games all season. The boys' team went on to win two games in the sectionals before losing in the quarter finals. The girls' team also won two games including an overtime thriller vs. Tappan Zee and advanced to the semi-finals in Westchester County Center where they lost to Peekskill. Diver, Jessie Rotering and bowler, Stefanie Dobert narrowly missed qualifying for the state championships. Talah Hughes and Leandra Echi earned 5th and 9th All State honors for girls basketball and for the boys, Elijah Hughes earned 5th team All State. The spring was a season for the ages. The baseball team was arguably the best team to ever don the blue and gold. En route to a league championship and a 19 – 3 record, the team set the standard for teams that follow. Not to be forgotten were the accomplishments of the boys and girls track and field teams. The boys team placed second in the league and in the Class B Championships. This year marked the first time three golfers from Beacon qualified for Sectional Championships. Emily Kidd, Britni Grohosky and Mary Jacketti were among the best golfers in section one to qualify.

BASEBALL WINS LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP

The varsity baseball team finished with the regular best record in Section One at 18-2. Season highlights include winning the Spring Bash tournament for the second time by defeating Section 9's Cornwall, winning their third consecutive league championship by going undefeated in the league, and also beating Ketcham in the final to capture the Ricky Lombardo tournament as well as going 8-0 against AA teams. During the season the Bulldogs were ranked as high as #2 in the state. The team also travelled to Cooperstown visiting the Baseball Hall of Fame, watching Cortland play at Oneonta and also beat Section 4's Waverly High 7-0 at Doubleday Field. Post season began with the Bulldogs being seed #1 in the sectional tournament. The team beat Sleepy Hollow in the opening round but was upset by 9th seed Lakeland in the quarter finals. The team finished the season with a 19-3 record.

The coaching staff would like to recognize the senior class for their leadership, class and work ethic this season: Josh Catalano, Nick Dinapoli, Nick Golembiewski, Andrew Grella, Patrick Schetter, and Tony Romanelli. Coach Atwell will always remember the team's dedication of this season to the memory of his father. This was a season that will be remembered forever. Their accomplishments have set the standard for generations of future Bulldogs.



Eight Teams and 204 Spring Athletes Earn Academic Excellence

This spring season, all eight varsity teams earned the NYSPHSAA Scholar Team Athlete Award; Baseball, Softball, Boys and Girls Golf, Boys and Girls Track, Boys Tennis and Girls Lacrosse. This was the first time all varsity teams in a season earned the Team Scholar Athlete Award. 67% of the 304 athletes who participated in spring sports maintained an average of 85 or better. The girls golf team had the highest GPA among all the varsity teams in the athletic program with a 96.1 GPA.

Our coaches have done a tremendous job making academic achievement a priority. It is through the efforts of coaches and teachers working together, that our athletes have been able to attain academic success.

NYS SPRING TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Beacon Track traveled to Cicero North Syracuse for the Outdoor Track and Field Championships June 6th and 7th with four athletes. Sophomore Paige Baisley competed in her 2nd Spring State Championships in the high jump. Seeded 17th, she finished 13th among Division 1 girls with a clearance of 5 feet 2 inches. Senior James Brown cleared 6 feet 4 inches on his first attempt to finish 3rd among Division 1 boys in the high jump.

In the horizontal jumps, sophomore Terrel Davis and Rayvon Grey finished 9th and 4th respectively in the Division 1 Long Jump. Rayvon then jumped a personal best 47 feet 11 1/2 inches in the triple jump to finish 2nd. On Saturday, Rayvon returned for the Federation Championship which pits the best 8 jumpers in the state against each other and he finished 5th in the Triple Jump and 2nd in the Long Jump with a leap of 23 feet 6 inches. He ends the season ranked number three in the country for sophomores in Triple Jump and number nine in the country for sophomores in Long Jump.

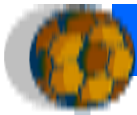
